Ricky Hatton takes on Juan Urango for IBF World Junior Welterweight Title on Classic Fight Night on fubo Sports Network

PHILADELPHIA (May 21, 2021)– Popular two division champion Ricky Hatton looked to reclaim the IBF world junior welterweight title from undefeated Juan Urango in a bout that will be featured tonight in the next installment of Classic Fight Night at 8 PM ET on fubo Sports Network.

Urango was surging with a record of 17-0 -1, with 13 knockouts, and was looking to make the first defense of the title Hatton relinquished. Urango was considered one of the hardest punchers in boxing at the time. Hatton (41-0, 30 KOs) surrendered the IBF world junior welterweight title when he moved up to beat WBA world welterweight champion Luis Collazo.

Ricky Hatton – Luis Collazo Classic WBA Welterweight World Title Fight to be Streamed on fubo Sports Network

HATTON BACKS CROLLA TO MAKE HISTORY IN MANCHESTER

SAN DIEGO, CALIF.- September 22, 2016 – -Ricky Hatton has backed Anthony Crolla to become the first Englishman to win the Ring Magazine Lightweight title in his unification blockbuster with Jorge Linares at the Manchester Arena on Saturday , live at the Manchester Arena on Saturday September 24, live on AWE-A Wealth of Entertainment & www.klowdtv.com

The start time of the show will be 2:30 PM ET / 11:30 AM PT.

Hatton landed the Super-Welterweight strap in the same arena in April 2006 when he forced Kostya Tszyu to quit after 11 thrilling rounds.

The 'Hitman' will be ringside on Saturday night where Crolla aims to become Britain's 18th Ring magazine king and join Scottish legends Ken Buchanan and Jim Watt as winners of the prestigious strap in the 135lbs division.

Hatton's fighting days are as memorable for his fanatical supports as his achievements in the ring, and the Manchester legend is delighted to see Crolla's support growing as his remarkable story continues.

"Where Anthony has come from is a great example," said Hatton. "It's not where you start in boxing, it's where you finish. He lost a six rounder early in his career and to Derry Mathews later on, everyone wrote him off and to achieve what he has is test of his character. I'm very proud of him.

"Anthony is lovely kid, some say he is too nice to be a boxer but there is a mean streak there. He has developed in to a good all round fighter, he has a very exciting style and is brutal body puncher.

"I know he can do the business against Jorge Linares and I'll be beaming with pride to see him lift that Ring Magazine belt.

"My proudest achievement was my fan base in my career above everything. Anthony has an amazing following now and it's great to see a fellow Mancunian being such a big draw in our city

"I became the first Brit to win the Ring Magazine fighter of

the year award. Which was a huge honour. I won the Ring Magazine belt 10 years ago and it is the accolade that proves you are the best in your weight division, it is the ultimate achievement. It looks like the belt from the Rocky movies and its very old school which adds to the glamour of it."

"There's only one Ricky Hatton and there will only ever be one," said Crolla. "If I can get a bit of the support and success that Ricky had I'll be over the moon. The crowds at the Perez and Barroso fights were unbelievable and I am sure it's going to be rocking on Saturday too."

"I'm just so proud that I've been able to pay the fans back for their incredible support I've received. I'm not the kind of fighter that will run his mouth at press conferences or call people out, but I will happily fight anyone. You can't want it more than me, no-one does. I'm still taken aback by it all really, I'm just a normal lad that trains hard, but things are going well and the harder you train, the luckier you get."

Crolla's clash Linares with is part of a huge night of action in Manchester as John Ryder defends his WBA International Middleweight title against Jack Arnfield.

Callum Johnson lands his first title action against Willbforce Shihepo for the Commonwealth Light-Heavyweight title, unbeaten Light-Heavyweight Hosea Burton will be in title action Conor Benn tastes his fifth night of action in the paid ranks.

Anthony Crolla vs. Jorge Linares is a 12-round fight for the WBA, WBC Diamond and the Ring Magazine Lightweight World Championships presented by Matchroom Boxing and Golden Boy Promotions in association with Akihiko Honda's Teiken Boxing Gym.

Ricky Hatton: “Browne winning the Heavyweight title would be huge for my company”

San Diego, CA – March 3, 2016 – This Saturday afternoon, March 5th, undefeated and number-two ranked WBA heavyweight contender Lucas “Big Daddy” Browne (23-0-0) will battle defending WBA World Heavyweight champ Ruslan Chagaev (34-2-1) for his belt. The bout will be broadcast LIVE in the United States on AWE – A Wealth of Entertainment.

The action begins live at 2 PM ET / 11 AM PT.

Browne is promoted by former two-division world champion and British Idol, Ricky Hatton and the Manchester great has a lot on the line this Saturday if Browne can come through with the victory.

“It would be massive for my company, very significant,” said Hatton. “Lucas would be my first world champion as a promoter, and it’s fantastic that it would be a Heavyweight title. I was a two-time world champion as a fighter. I have trained a world champion, so I don’t know many people who have done all three as a trainer, fighter and a promoter. ”

To have Browne in this position, the fighter turned promoter, is thrilled for his fighter, being that Browne was not sought after in his early career.

“I am very happy for Lucas. He came up the hard way. He was not an Olympian. In fact, it was just a few years ago, that he was working doors at the night clubs and he has put in the hard work and this is a big night for me and my company.”

Despite the fight being in enemy territory, "The Hitman", feels his fighter is in good hands as Browne is being trained by former super middleweight world champion and British great, Nigel Benn.

"He has a great team behind him. An excellent trainer. It is going to be a tough job, but I firmly believe that he will win the fight. It will be difficult as Chagaev was a big amateur and now a world champion. Lucas who has always been known as a puncher is moving a lot better on his feet. Very fluid. Lucas has also added speed and has had great preparation."

Being in enemy territory, Hatton knows that the fight may come down to the judges, and he believes that Browne will get a fair shake.

"I would like to think that Lucas will not need a knockout to win, but judges can be swayed by the hometown fans, but this being a world title fight, I expect world class judges. That being said, Lucas should not leave it to chance."

With a Browne win, there is a chance a good portion heavyweight division would run through the United Kingdom as Unified champion Tyson Fury and potentially Anthony Joshua (who fights IBF champion Charles Martin on April 9) would hold most of the hardware in boxing's glamour division.

"I thought about that. I get along well with Eddie Hearn, who has Joshua. I get a long great with my former promoter Frank Warren and you can also throw David Haye in there who is back. I can't see any problems making fights with Joshua or Fury and we would have some massive heavyweights fights here. Lucas has fought five times here and has a good fan base."

"The only thing that I am gutted about on Saturday is that I can't be there with Lucas when he wins as I train a lot of young fighters and I have four of them fighting on Saturday and they need me in London with them, but Saturday will be a great day for my company."

There will be a three fight undercard beginning at 2 PM.

In a 10-round Heavyweight bout, Edmund Gerber (25-2, 16 K0's) of Schwerin, Germany will fight Brian Minto (41-10, 26 K0's) of Butler, PA.

In a 10-round bout for the IB0 International Welterweight title, Vishkahn Murzabekov (12-0, 6 K0's) of Russia takes on former world title challenger Ali Funeka (37-5-3, 30 K0's) of South Africa.

Tyrone Spong (2-0, 2 K0's) of Miami, Florida battles David Gogishvilli (12-0, 8 Ko's) of Gori, Georgia in a 6-round Cruiserweight bout.
