Martinez of Tijuana, Mexico has a record of 11-4-1 with five knockouts has wins over Jose Galvez (7-0-1) & Daniel Nava (7-1-2) will be looking for the most significant win of his career.

Shelestyuk is co-promoted by Banner Promotions and Thompson Boxing.

"We expect a great performance from Taras on Friday night," said Arthur Pelullo, President of Banner Promotions.

"With a good win on Friday, we will bring him back in August in a bigger fight. We feel he is right on the cusp of a great

opportunity."
